## **MINUTES**

**CALL TO ORDER:** A quorum was established; the meeting was called to order at 10:01 a.m. by George Brazil, Chair.

### **BOARD CHAIR'S REPORT:**

George Brazil delivered the Chair's Report. He stated that CCIDC continued its mission in 2026 through implementation of the Strategic Plan, updates to the IDEX® Examination aligned with the 2025 California Building Code, and enhancements to certification systems. He reported expanded outreach and stakeholder engagement, stable finances with expenses remaining within budget, and strengthened financial reserves. Brazil emphasized the continued need for public awareness and identified organizational priorities, including the Sunset Review, completion of examination updates, and expanded education and outreach efforts.

### **NEW BOARD MEMBER:**

Brazil made a motion, seconded by Menches, to approve candidate Adam Sampson to fill the open 2025 Public Director seat. The motion carried unanimously.

### **MINUTES:**

Stead made a motion, seconded by Fabiola, to approve the Board meeting minutes for September 20, 2025. The motion carried unanimously.

### **Public Comment Period**

**TREASURER’S REPORT:**

Julissa Garcia presented the financial report as of December 31, 2025. She reported total income of \$261,880, representing 93.95 percent of the annual budget, and total expenditures of \$222,973, representing 84.88 percent of the annual budget, resulting in net income of \$41,906.87 for the fiscal year. Garcia reviewed the balance sheet, which reflected total assets of \$111,933.48, and presented the budget-to-actual and profit and loss statements for the fiscal year. She also presented the 2024 audited financial statements.

Garcia made a motion, seconded by Menches, to approve the 2026 CCIDC budget. The motion carried unanimously.

Garcia made a motion, seconded by Brazil, to approve the 2024 audited financial statements. The motion carried unanimously.

**EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR QUARTERLY REPORT:**

Roze Wiebe provided a quarterly update covering administrative activities, outreach, legislation, and examination development. Wiebe reported that the 2026 Board and Committee meeting schedule had been posted. She noted that outreach efforts included coordination with educational institutions and industry organizations. Wiebe stated that the Sunset Review questionnaire had been submitted to the Legislature, with a legislative hearing anticipated in March 2026.

Following adoption of the updated California Building Codes effective January 1, 2026, CCIDC advanced updates to the IDEX® California Examination, including validation of revised examination content and coordination with Measure Learning and ProctorU for implementation during the May 2026 examination window. Legislative and advocacy information had also been updated on the CCIDC website.

Wiebe presented the Certified Interior Designer status report as of December 31, 2025. She reported that CCIDC had 5,614 certified individuals, including 1,646 active and 3,968 inactive Certified Interior Designers. Wiebe also reported on plan check denials submitted to CCIDC and stated that the organization continued working with jurisdictions regarding acceptance of the CID stamp and compliance with the Certified Interior Designer Title Act.

**CERTIFICATION PROGRAM MANAGER’S REPORT:**

Camryn Burns presented an update on CCIDC marketing, social media activity, and IDEX® California Examination activity for the fourth quarter of 2025. She reported that communications across all platforms focused on certification guidance, meeting notices, committee activities, and calendar reminders. LinkedIn continued to serve as the primary platform for certification discovery, while Instagram and Facebook maintained meeting visibility and reminders.

Burns reported that Instagram had 2,145 followers, Facebook had 6,600 followers, and LinkedIn had 718 followers with a 2.2 percent engagement rate. She stated that CEU and IDEX® posts generated the strongest engagement and that outreach requests from schools and professionals increased during the quarter.

Burns presented the IDEX® California candidate report as of December 31, 2025. She reported that 265 applications had been received in 2025, with 47 candidates approved and certified and 237 pending examinations. Additional pending categories included 44 awaiting documentation, 99 who had failed and had not yet retaken the examination, 79 who had not yet scheduled, and 41 scheduled for IDEX®.

For the May examination cycle, 27 candidates attended and 21 passed, resulting in a 78 percent pass rate. For the October cycle, 41 candidates attended and 30 passed, resulting in a 73 percent pass rate. She confirmed that the examination data tables in the Board binder reflected these totals.

### **COMMITTEE REPORTS:**

#### **Advocacy Committee:**

Roze Wiebe reported that the Advocacy Committee continued to monitor legislation and regulatory activity affecting Certified Interior Designers in California and provided updates regarding legislative developments impacting the profession. She reported that the next committee meeting was scheduled for February 4, 2026, and that participation information was available on the CCIDC website.

#### **Education Committee:**

Roze Wiebe reported that the Education Committee coordinated with educators, students, and Certified Interior Designers regarding awareness of the Certified Interior Designer Title Act and continuing education related to the IDEX® California Examination. She reported that the next committee meeting was scheduled for February 11, 2026, and that participation information was available on the CCIDC website.

#### **Marketing and Outreach Committee:**

George Brazil reported that the Marketing and Outreach Committee continued outreach to interior design school programs and distributed educational resources supporting awareness of the Certified Interior Designer Title Act. He reported that the next committee meeting was scheduled for February 3, 2026, and that participation information was available on the CCIDC website.

### **LEGISLATIVE UPDATE:**

Roze Wiebe reported on legislative activity affecting the interior design profession in California. She stated that the legislative session was in its early stages and that bills were beginning to be introduced for the second year of the two-year session, with additional updates expected the following month. Participation information was available on the CCIDC website.

### **STRATEGIC PLANNING:**

Roze Wiebe reviewed the 2026 Strategic Plan, including financial planning through expanded educational programs, sponsorship opportunities, and partnerships. She discussed marketing and outreach efforts designed to increase awareness of CCIDC and the Certified Interior Designer credential through digital engagement, webinars,

and CEU programs, along with outreach to students, professional organizations, and interior design businesses.

Wiebe reported on the IDEX® Examination revision schedule, including ICC question review, implementation of approved examination changes, and updated educational courses. She also noted continued collaboration with allied organizations, including ARIDO, CALBO, CLCid, and ICC.

**NOTE FOR THE RECORD:**

Members of the audience were permitted to participate in general discussions throughout the meeting and on all agenda items during the open session.

**ADJOURNMENT:**

A motion was made by Brazil, seconded by Menches, to adjourn the meeting at 10:57 a.m. The motion carried unanimously.
